

The Depth of Christ (Mark 10:32-34)

Theme: The depth of Christ is hard to fathom.

In Mark 10:32-34 we see 3 truths about Christ.

1. He is a teacher (v.32)

The real impactors are those who teach you

With what they say

With what they do

2. He is a servant (v33-34)

Delivered to the religious leaders

Condemned to die

Handed to the Gentiles

Disrespected

Killed

This looks like the acts of a victim. Christ is not, nor was He ever, a victim. We are not to pity Christ, we are to thank Him.

3. He is a winner (v.34)

People love a winner

Christ is not often pictured as a winner but rather an effeminate weakling.

He rose from the dead. He is the ultimate victor.

Discussion Questions

- Do we allow teachers and mentors to hold a more prominent place in our hearts than the savior they represent? How do we avoid this pitfall?**
- What did Christ do for us? Why did He do this?**
- What does it mean to view Christ as a winner? If we are honest, do we view humility as weakness? If so, how can we ever be Christlike without humility?**
